## About the Author

After graduating from the University of Michigan, **Russell T. Hitt** began his long, distinguished career in journalism as a reporter for the *Detroit Free Press*. He later embarked on a journey that took him to China and Paris, where he worked for an international publication. While in his 30s, after rededicating his life to Christ, Hitt earned a master's degree in journalism from Northwestern University. One of his major contributions to Christian journalism was as editor of *Eternity* magazine. Hitt died in 1992 at the age of 87.

**Stephen Saint** was born in Quito, Ecuador, to Nate and Marj Saint—the middle of three Saint children (between Kathy and Phil). He was four years old when his father was killed by the Waodani Indians. When Steve was ten, Marj took her family to live in a Waodani village. After going to high school in Quito, Steve attended and graduated from Wheaton College. Steve and his wife, Ginny, have four children. Steve and Ginny took the family to Ecuador in the 1990s, where they lived with the Waodani people. Later he founded I-TEC, a company that seeks to help indigenous people use technology to become independent.
